#### **General Instructions:**

U<sub>1</sub> test shall be held in March, the U<sub>2</sub> test shall be held in May and the U<sub>3</sub> test shall be held in September. The 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Examination shall be held in July 2017 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Examination will be held in ending October 2017. Unit Test, (I), (II) and (III) carries 10% of Marks each. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester carries 30% of Marks and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester carries 40% of Marks.
