Informal Invitations

Main Characteristics

- Informal invitations follow the pattern of ordinary personal letters. These letters are written to relatives, friends and acquaintances
- These letters are first/second person presentations.
- Personal feelings and emotions find an expression
- The writer's address is given in the usual place
- The salutation is usually 'Dear' plus 'name'
- > The date of writing is given, but the year is generally omitted
- The style and the tone are relaxed and informal
- Different tenses are used as the sense demands
- The complimentary close is: 'Yours sincerely'
